

Option 1 - Fitting a blind INSIDE a recess

It's just 3 simple measurements!






Step 1 - Measure the width inside the recess at the top (A) in the position as to where you want the blind to fit. Then also at the bottom (B) and then record the smallest measurement of the two. This will allow for obstacles such as dado rails and protruding tiles.

Step 2 - Measure inside the drop **(C)**, and record this measurement. Upon receiving these sizes, we will make the necessary allowances to ensure a snug fit!

Option 2 - Fitting a blind OUTSIDE a recess

It's just 2 simple measurements!





Step 1 - If you would like your blinds to hang outside of your window recess, you will need to decide on the finished size that you would prefer. We suggest that a blind should project at least **80mm** over the whole recess e.g. **40mm** on either side.

Step 2 - Measure and record the finished width (A) and the drop (B) that you require including the additional 80mm minimum. We will then make your blinds exactly to those measurements.
